2. Please remember that we are a family club and we hope that all supporters remember this. Do not use profane language or harass referees, players or coaches.
3. Applaud good play by the visiting team as well as our own.
4. Show respect for our team's opponents. Without them there would not be a match.
5. Sportsmanship and respect are at the core of Rugby Union and all involved should denounce the use of violence in all forms, at every opportunity.
6. Verbal abuse of players or referees cannot be accepted in any shape or form.
7. Players or referees are not fair targets for ignorant behaviour.
8. Encourage young players to play by the Laws of the Game and to respect the game of Rugby Union.
9. Spectators can and should contribute to the enjoyment of the event and all involved.
10. Be proud of your club and the Game of Rugby.
